Regarding your letter dated the 14<sup>th</sup> May 2024.

LCC Highways does not have any objections regarding the proposed increase width of existing vehicle site access and provision of pedestrian access gate with footpath and are of the opinion that the proposed development will not have a significant impact on highway safety, capacity or amenity in the immediate vicinity of the site.

As part of the increase in width to the vehicle access, we would request that tactile paving and a dropped kerb is provided to offer a safe crossing point to pedestrians. We would also require the yellow line markings to be moved so they are alongside the new kerb line.

The new site access and associated off-site works as laid out above will need to be constructed. The Highway Authority hereby reserves the right to provide the highway works within the highway associated with this proposal. Provision of the highway works includes design, procurement of the work by contract and supervision of the works. The applicant is advised to contact Stewart Gailey [REDACTED] to finalise the detail of the highway works before works begin on site.
