Newburgh Parish Council has made FOI requests to the Environment Agency as follows:

1 The results of inspections and reports on Round O Quarry undertaken by the Environmental Agency under Environmental Permits/Authority between 2014 and 2022

2 The results of any analysis of the quality of water or any other effluents from the quarry from 2014 to 2022

The Environment Agency has provided 54 reports submitted over a period from 2013-2021.

comprised quarterly reports, annual reports and regular CAR reports

Newburgh Parish Council assessment (herewith) points to three areas of concern:

The overfilling that has taken place and particularly the fact that this was evident as early as 2013 when the northern sector was already complete and overfilled

The discharges and water run-off from the site and the indication in 2017 that "a final regrading design is likely to be required, supported by a new flood risk and surface management plan". No evidence of this has been traced

The lack of external monitoring of the site

Newburgh Parish Council underlines its earlier objection to the application given that the Restoration Plan fails to support the evidence and recommendations in the available Environment

Agency reports.

It further requests that external monitoring by the EA should take place into water-related problems

downstream of the Quarry so that reassurances can be given to Newburgh residents that there will

be no adverse impacts of the quarry restoration.

The Council requests that the planning application be deferred to allow time for the EA to investigate these problems.
